His recent work has included developing national quality indicators. He was previously regional clinical lead for the Darzi Review of the NHS and has also worked with the National Audit Office, Prime Ministers Delivery Unit and the Healthcare Commission. He has also advised overseas governments on organisation of emergency care.
